

Hi! We are Jeremy and Angie, the duo behind Discover the Burgh. We are engineers turned travel writers based in the North Side near the Mexican War Streets.



The Pittsburgh Guidebook is available in both print and digital formats.




Our digital copy of the book is available as a PDF download for \$10+ tax directly on our book's website.



#### Phipps Conservatory

#### Ohiopyle State Park

The Laurel Highlands is home to many great parks, and one of the most popular is the 20,500-acre Ohiopyle State Park in the town of the same name. This one features several beautiful waterfalls including the 30-foot Cucumber Falls, a natural waterslide (best for kids- it can leave a nasty bruise!), and some of the best whitewater rafting in the region in the summer months! Add on a visit to Fallingwater or Fort Necessity National Battlefield to make a full day if you have a bit of extra time.
